We commit to a Uganda where:


- Justice is not for the few but for all.

- Introduce Eco-Learning Curricula to instill environmental responsibility.
- Expand vocational and digital training centers nationwide.
- Provide free sanitary materials, school meals, and technology for learners.

Universal Healthcare as a Right




Health is a human right. The EPU will:

- Establish the National Universal Health Service (NUHS) with free or subsidized care.
- Modernize all district hospitals and integrate traditional medicine.
- Implement a National Health Insurance Fund for all citizens.



Economic Equality and Fair Wages





- A progressive tax system targeting luxury and speculative wealth.
- Enforcement of a National Living Wage across sectors.

Legal protection for informal workers and artisans.



No Ugandan should live below the poverty line. EPU will:

- Launch the National Livelihood Support Scheme (NLSS) providing job guarantees, food aid, and microfinance.
- Establish community cooperatives and fair-trade markets in every district.

Empowerment of Women



Women will be central to Uganda's rebirth. EPU will:

- Guarantee equal pay, property rights, and political representation.
- Enforce anti-GBV (Gender-Based Violence) laws and fund shelters for survivors.
- Create Women Entrepreneurship and Credit Funds in all regions.




Labor Rights and Dignity for Workers

- Enforce strict penalties against wetland and forest encroachment.




Technology and Innovation for Public Good



EPU will position Uganda as Africa's green innovation hub.


- Build Digital Innovation Parks in all regions.

- Upgrade slums with sanitation, lighting, and roads.


Food Security through Sustainable Agriculture

- Ensure inclusive representation in public service and Parliament.




Cultural Preservation and National Identity



Uganda's diversity is its beauty.


- Promote local languages, music, and heritage.

Vision VVV

To build a united, empowered, and compassionate community of EPU members who support one another in times of need and grow together through collective strength, solidarity, and self-reliance.

Mission VVV

To create a sustainable members' fund where contributions made in the spirit of solidarity provide a safety net during moments of critical illness and loss, while also empowering members financial through literacy, entrepreneurship, skills and development programs that promote dignity, independence, and prosperity.



Governance and Fiscal Reform Chapter

Reforming Government Institutions and Eradicating Corruption

Corruption is Uganda's deepest wound. EPU will lead a moral, institutional, and technological revolution to uproot it permanently.

Step-by-Step Institutional Reforms

- 1. Constitutional Accountability Amendment: criminalize unexplained wealth and enforce annual public asset declarations.
- 2. Independent Anti-Corruption Authority (IACA): merge all anti-graft bodies into a single, non-presidential entity.
- **3**. **Digital Governance & Public Ledger:** blockchain-powered systems for procurement, payroll, and licensing.
- **4**. **Citizen Accountability Councils:** local watchdogs to oversee projects and budgets.
- **5**. **Judicial and Public Service Clean-Up:** regional anti-corruption courts, lifestyle audits, and merit-based hiring.





Overcoming National Debt and Fiscal Mismanagement

Uganda's debt crisis is a symptom of systemic failure. EPU's **Debt Recovery and Fiscal Reform Plan (DRFRP)** will restore economic sovereignty.

Six-Step Debt Recovery Mechanism

- 1. Comprehensive Debt Audit & Renegotiation
- **2. Expenditure Rationalization,** eliminate waste, shrink Parliament, reduce foreign travel and allowances.
- **3. Revenue Revival:** reform URA, digitize tax collection, and introduce Wealth & Property Taxes.
- **4. Industrial Revival Fund:** invest recovered funds in agro-industries and renewable energy.
- **5. Transparent Budgeting:** publicize all budgets and create People's Budget Forums.
- **6. Fiscal Responsibility Act**: cap national debt at 45% of GDP and tie borrowing to measurable benefits.

Rebuilding Trust and National Ownership

Through education, technology, and community vigilance, EPU will cultivate a Clean Government Movement - where corruption is not just punished but despised.







Foreign Policy and International Relations



The Ecological Party of Uganda (EPU) recognizes that ecological, social, and economic challenges transcend national borders. Our foreign policy is guided by solidarity, ecological diplomacy, and mutual respect, ensuring Uganda plays a constructive role in promoting peace, sustainability, and inclusive development globally.

1. Regional Integration and East African Cooperation

EPU shall actively engage within the East African Community (EAC) to advance:

- Sustainable regional trade and equitable access to green markets
- Joint cross-border environmental protection and reforestation initiatives
- Free movement of eco-innovation, technology, and knowledge
- Climate adaptation programs and green jobs across member states
- Ecological education and youth empowerment exchanges

As an active member of the **East African Greens Federation (EAGF)**, EPU will coordinate regional efforts in advancing environmental justice, democratic governance, and the green transition.

2. Continental Partnerships

Through the African Greens Federation (AGF), EPU will:

- Strengthen partnerships with African Green movements and governments for shared ecological transformation
- Advocate for a **continental African Green Deal** emphasizing renewable energy, biodiversity conservation, and sustainable agriculture
- Support African unity, fair trade, and responsible management of natural resources
- Promote democracy, peacekeeping, and the empowerment of women and youth in governance



3. Global Engagement

In partnership with the Global Greens (GG), EPU will:

- Align Uganda's policies with international environmental and climate justice standards
- Participate actively in global green forums, UN summits, and sustainability conventions
- Promote a Just Global Economic Order that protects people and the planet from exploitation
- Strengthen Uganda's participation in green technology exchange, research, and sustainable investment platforms

4. Guiding Principles

EPU's foreign relations will always uphold:

- Mutual respect and sovereignty among nations
- Peaceful coexistence and dialogue as foundations for conflict resolution
- Environmental justice and human rights as central pillars of diplomacy
- Solidarity with all oppressed peoples and defenders of ecological and democratic values
